The Story of Honey

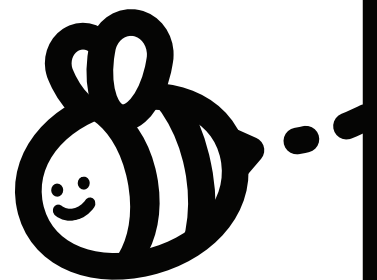


Beekeepers work with honeybees every day.

man-made shelves called, “frames”.

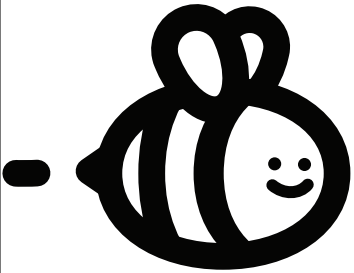
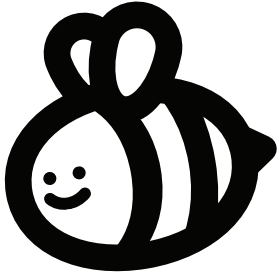
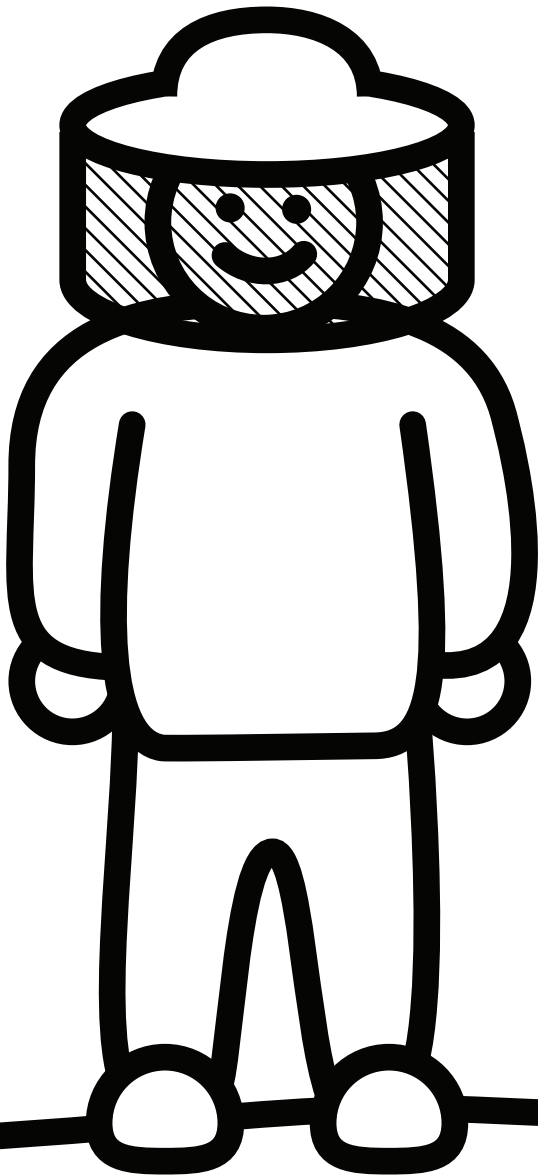
Beekeepers wear protective clothing

put into barrels and sent to Bee Maid Honey.

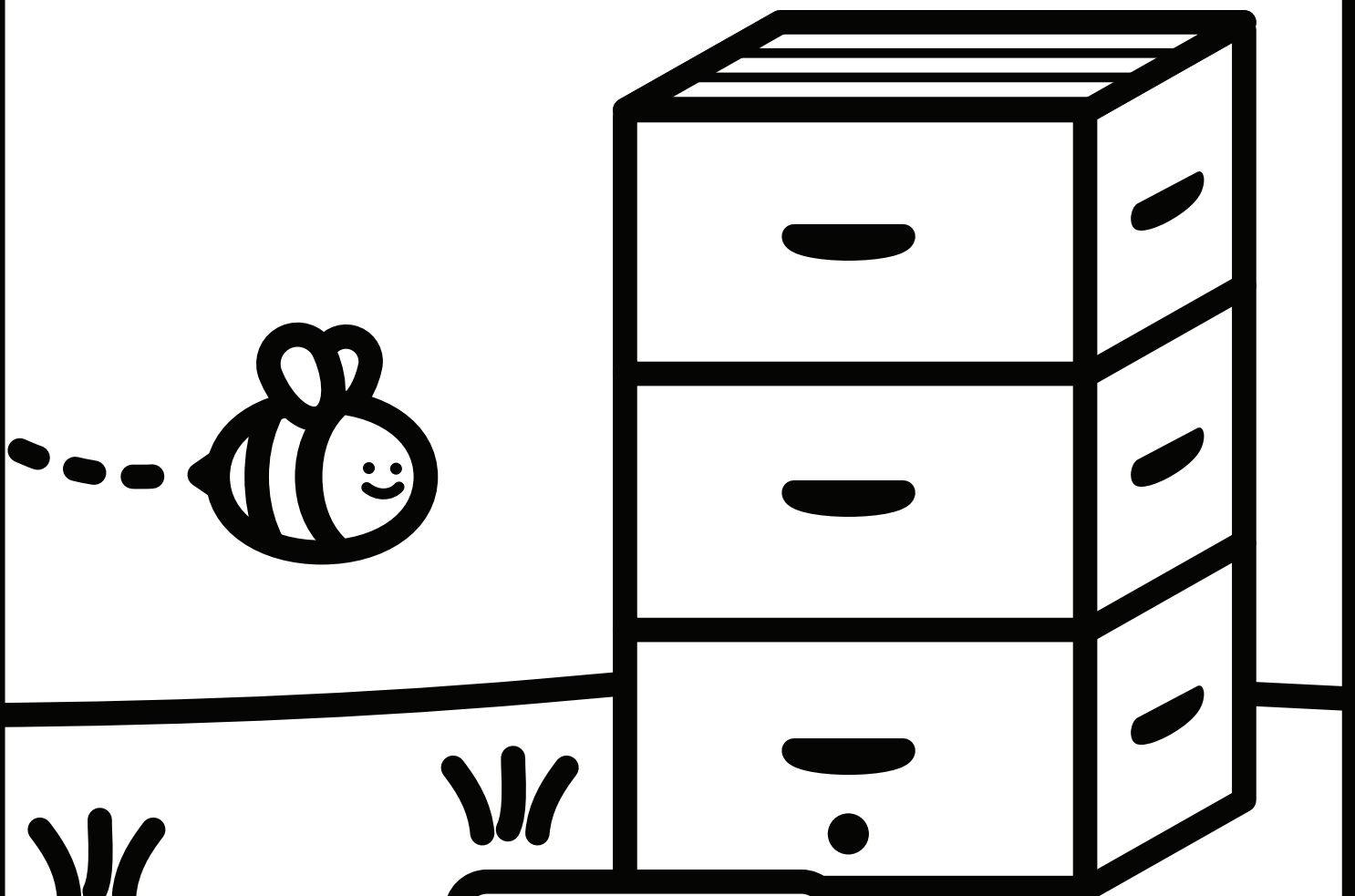
